

DISPOSAL

- Encapsulator Rx may be placed in a landfill with no hazardous classifications.
- Encapsulator Rx encapsulates both acids and caustics in their liquid and gaseous states. While doing this, EncapsulatoRx can absorb "regulated materials".
- Disposal regulations are determined by quantity and content of the spill.
- The disposal method will be determined by the user according to local, state and federal (40 CFR 302.4) regulations.

Encapsulator Rx:

- Has been determined to be non-hazardous in accordance with 29CFR 1910.1200
- Carcinogenic listings: NTP-none, IARC-none, OSHA-none, ACGIH-none
- CERCLA, State and Local Planning (Reportable Quantities): Not Required
- SARA Title III Superfund: the product in its purchased form is not regulated under the SARA hazard categories according to the EPA "Hazard Categories: under sections 311 and 312 of the Superfund Amendment.
